Faith: Taking God At His Word Acts 27:1-2, 14-26 (Pew Bible p. 1122)



Faith is a multi-faceted response to God.

1. Confidence that Jesus is in authority... over all things, including "your" thing, Matthew 8:5-13.

A shipwreck can be the best thing for your faith when it comes with a promise from God. Acts 27

Acts 27:23-25 – 23 "For this very night an angel of the God to whom I belong and whom I serve stood before me, 24 saying, 'Do not be afraid, Paul; you must stand before Caesar; and behold, God has granted you all those who are sailing with you.' 25 "Therefore, keep up your courage, men, *for I believe God that it will turn out exactly as I have been told.*

2. Taking God at His Word... more than your feelings, circumstances or other people, Acts 27:25.
