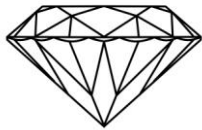

Faith: Trusting In The Person of God

1 Samuel 3:1-18

(Pew Bible p. 284)



Faith is a multi-faceted response to God.

1. Confidence that Jesus is in authority...
over all things, including “your” thing, Matthew 8:5-13.

2. Taking God at His Word...
more than your feelings, circumstances or other people, Acts 27:25.

A 3rd *Practical Facet to a Biblical Faith*: When you are perplexed and have no specific promise from God, you respond by:

3. Trusting submission to the Person of God...
even when you don't understand. 1 Samuel 3:18
