1. LOSS (Acknowledging reality): v. 14, *Lazarus is dead*

2. SADNESS (Role of feelings): v. 33, *Jesus was deeply moved in spirit and troubled*

3. TEARS (Expressing the grief): v. 35, *Jesus wept*

4. GOD (Aggressively pursue Him & His ways by faith): vv. 40-42
If you believe, you will see the glory of God...Jesus said, “Father...”
